

Book Report Lesson Sequence

Lesson 1 - Book Report Overview

Whole class: View 'How To Write a Book Report.pptx'. Discuss.

Task: Choose a text to conduct a book report on and begin/continue reading.

Lesson 2 - How To Write a Good Book Report

Whole Class: Read 'How To Write a Good Book Report.pdf' together. Give students a copy.

Task: Continue reading own text for book report.

Lesson 3 - Modelling Book Report Writing

Whole class: Read a well-known picture storybook or short chapter book to the class. For example, Cinderella (see Cinderella Book Report.docx)

Using 'How To Write a Good Book Report.pdf', begin on board to write, in dot points, the answers to the first paragraph. Then turn that into a paragraph. Ask for student input to do this.

Task: Begin writing draft book report, using dot points and 'How To Write a Good Book Report.pdf' as a guide.

Lesson 4 - Modelling Book Report Writing

Whole class: Model on board, in dot points, paragraphs 2 and 3. Then turn into paragraphs. Read and distribute 'Student Book Report Rubric.docx'.

Task: Continue with own book report.

Lesson 5 onwards - Continue book report independently.

Task: Own book report.

Final Lesson - Presentation

Students present/hand in their book report. Complete 'Book Report Student Assessment.docx'. Teacher completes 'Book Report Teacher Assessment.docx'.
