

How to Write a Good Book Report

Paragraph 1 - Introduction/General Information about the book.

- Title
- Author
- Type of Book (Genre. Eg. Fantasy, humour, science fiction, mystery, romance, biography).

Paragraph 2 - Main Character

- Describe the character. (eg. Appearance, emotions, relationships)
- I can identify with the character when...

Paragraph 3 - Other characters

- Details.

Paragraph 4 - Setting

- Describe the time and place of the story.
- Comments about the setting (eg. Setting makes story exciting, setting has an important effect on the main character, setting is/is not exciting or new, setting increased my knowledge of something).

Paragraph 5 - Theme

- What is the author trying to say in this story? What is his lesson in life? Is there a moral to the story?
- This is a story about (eg. Courage? Working hard? Doing the right thing? Greed? Love? Jealousy?).
- This book showed me/learned from this story...
- State a problem in the story and how it was solved...

Paragraph 6 - Plot: The action/summary of what happened in the story

- List up to 6 events that happened in the story in sequence.

Paragraph 7 - Evaluation of the book

- What did you think of the book? believe?
- What did you like about the book?
- Was the story predictable?
- What didn't you like about the book?
- Was the story believable?
- Was the story confusing or hard to
- The ending was....
