### Whole class:

Read Millie's Speech file (see bundled PDF) together. Discuss what this student did well.

### Task:

Continue to work on speech using template. Begin to write out draft speech, moving from dot points to sentences and paragraphs.

### Whole class:

#### Task:

Edit your speech, read to a friend for feedback on content. Does it make a good speech based on the template and videos viewed?

# Lesson 4

#### Whole Class:

#### Task:

Provide each student with a copy of the table and pair them up. Present speech to partner and receive feedback based on table.


Then keep practising speech making, making improvements based on feedback, OR, write speech in dot points on cards ready for official speech presentation.
